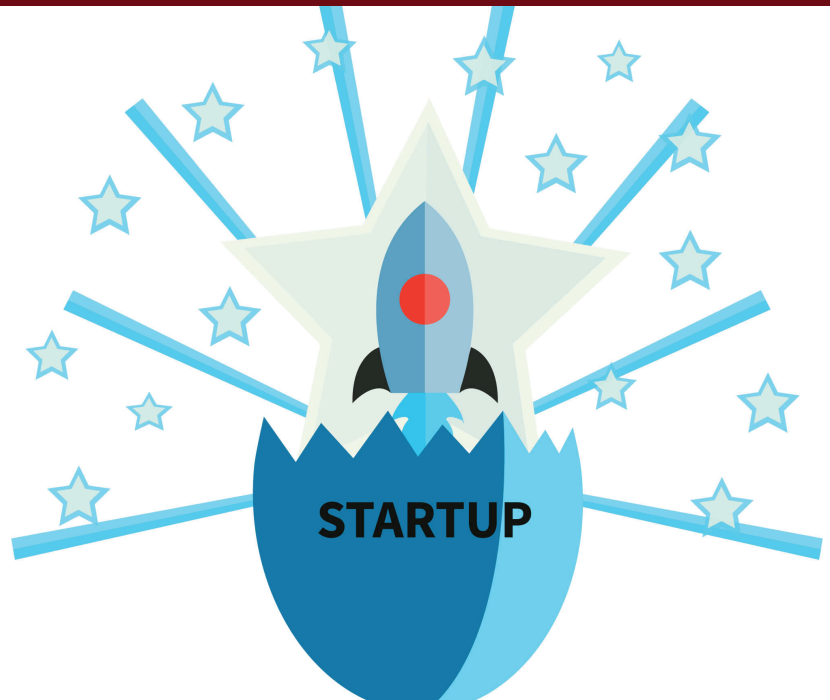


Incubate or Accelerate?
